How do I claim ABP MOC points?

eeds makes claiming your ABP MOC points as easy as 1-2-3! You can use the eeds app or eeds website:

Complete Course Evaluation
(required for credit)

Take MOC Post Test (Required for MOC Credit)

Claim ABP MOC Points
(available after you have completed the post test)

Step 1: Sign into Event
Once you are signed in, you unlock the MOC Post Test

Step 2: Complete the Course Evaluation & Take the MOC Post Test
Once you successfully complete the MOC Post Test, you are able to Claim ABP MOC Points

Step 3: Claim ABP MOC Points
This step MUST be completed to get your points. You must provide your ABP number, Date of Birth and give Tower Health CME permission to submit your MOC points to the Board.

How long do I have to take the MOC Post Test?

Please complete the MOC Post Test and Claim Your MOC Points within 2 weeks of the activity date.

I signed into the activity...I didn't take the MOC Post Test immediately but still have time. Where do I find it?

eeds app:

If you haven't completed the Activity Evaluation yet, you can use the eeds app. Go to "Follow Ups Required". Find the Activity Evaluation for the session date. You can now take the activity evaluation, take the MOC Post Test and Claim Your MOC Points on the app. Otherwise, log into your account on the eeds website.

eeds website:

You can log into your eeds account at <https://towerhealth.eeds.com>. From your Home Page, you should see "Claim MOC Points" under "Follow Up Needed".

How will I know if an individual session has ABP MOC points?

If an activity has fulfilled all the requirements for ABP MOC, you will see the MOC designation on the CME calendar and CME Flyer. And, if you see the MOC Post Test/Claim Your ABP MOC Points options after you sign in for attendance, the activity offers MOC!
