**Dr. Jason White** is a Pediatric Oncologist at St. Christopher's Hospital for Children, Section of Pediatric Oncology. After completing his general pediatrics residency at St. Christopher's, he served on active duty in the United States Navy. He then transitioned to the role of Bone Marrow Transplant Hospitalist at the Children's Hospital of Philadelphia before completing his Pediatric Hematology/Oncology fellowship at Nemours Children's Hospital. He is board certified in both General Pediatrics and Hospital Pediatrics. Dr. White has a special clinical interest in immune dysregulation and its relation to malignancy.
